

Guidelines for the YES Program Area Europe

Approved by Area Council 10 March 2018

YES Extension Support Program (YES)

Money from the YES program is dedicated to extension work in area, regions, districts and clubs and defines hereafter

- Extension in existing clubs to increase member numbers
- Extension through new clubs in countries and other geographical areas, where Y's Men already exist
- Extension through new clubs in geographical territories with no Y's Men's Clubs.

Where does the money come from?

The money in the YES Program comes from clubs and individuals who want to contribute to Extension of Y's Men International for immediate use.

The money is sent to the Area (AT), who will administrate the money on an account for YES.

The amount, there will be able to be used for a year, will be the amount on the account the 31th of December.

Make an application

Applications and interim reports shall contain:

- a) Definition of the aspects of the proposals and expected outcomes
- b) A plan with timetable
- c) Complete description (budget) of proposed use of funds.
- d) Details of expenditures such as travel costs, promotional materials, etc.
- e) Estimates of benefits anticipated (i.e. number of new member, member of new clubs).

For application use the "Application form for Area YES".

All requests must be received by ASD YES with copy to APE not later than January the 15th in this year, where the projects will start in the beginning of the July and end of June the next year.

Distribution of funds from Area to Region, districts or clubs

All applicants shall be advised of the Area Council's decisions.

Following ACM approval of requests, funds shall be paid by AT

- a) ½ part in the months of September
- b) ½ part in the months of March and upon receipt of an interim report,

Applicants who do not deliver an evaluation and/or completion report on previous YES projects, shall NOT be eligible to apply for another grant for a period of one (1) year.
